EXTREMISM AND TERRORISM IN EUROPE

• European Terrorist attack fatalities 2009-2022 (CSIS)

•	Jihadist	69.3 %
•	Right-wing	21.8%
•	Ethno-nationalists	6.9%
•	Left-wing	2%

- Right-wing attacks growing
- Link between electoral success of far-right political parties and far-right hate groups and terrorists?
- Hate crime same as terrorism?

CHALLENGES OF NEW WAVE OF RIGHT-WING TERRORISM

- "Leaderless Resistance" interacts with factors that create growing threat of right-wing terrorism
 - Few coordinated plots, but military experience, new technologies, better broadcasting of messages → more violence?
- Societal Factors
 - Anti-immigrant xenophobia
 - Acute political polarization
 - Conspiracy Theories abound
- Role of social media?

SOCIAL MEDIA

- How do terrorists use the internet/social media?
- Functions
 - Content hosting
 - Audience development
 - Brand control
 - Secure communications
 - Community maintenance
 - Financing
 - Information collection and curation
 - Variations with different platforms

EUROPEAN UNION APPROACH: DIGITAL SERVICES ACT (DSA)

- Role of internet and social media: 2020 right-wing attacks: One in five some significant social media noted as related to attack
- Digital Services Act (2022, to be in force 2024)

-Among other things, DSA intended to curb distribution of illegal, harmful content online

-Must remove content that pose a "societal risk"

-Fines for not removing content (accountability)
