

Dorothea Deitz Endowed Memorial Scholarship 2025-2026

The Dorothea Deitz Endowed Memorial Scholarship at Hofstra University was established in 2005 by the Dorothea Deitz Memorial Scholarship Fund Board of Directors to encourage young women in New York to pursue careers in the physical education teaching profession.

This scholarship is awarded by the Hofstra University Office of Financial Aid, upon the recommendation of the Dorothea Deitz Scholarship Committee, to full-time students who are enrolled in the Physical Education program. Students who have been admitted to Hofstra University and meet the requirements below are eligible to apply:

- * Female New York State high school graduate.
- * Demonstrated financial need must file FAFSA.
- * Minimum GPA of 3.0 or equivalent.
- * Evidence of character, physical education competence, participation in athletics, qualities of leadership, and community service.
- * Enrollment in the Physical Education/Teacher Certification program.

This scholarship is intended to fund a minimum award of \$1,000 per recipient and is not generally renewable. For consideration, the applicant must already be admitted to Hofstra University and attach the following items to the application:

- * Copy of current high school or college transcript. These should be web (NOT official) transcripts;
- * Two letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with the applicant's abilities. *Preference is* for letters on official letterhead with an original signature. In the case that this is not possible, we will accept letters that are emailed to us directly from the recommenders.
- * A completed FERPA Student Release consent form

The **FERPA Student Release consent form must be submitted along with this application**. This form can be downloaded from: www.hofstra.edu/pdf/acadrec FERPA.pdf. On this form, fill in Name of Authorized Person: *Dorothea Deitz Scholarship Committee*.

The completed application must be submitted by email by **Friday**, **June 27**, **2025** to be considered for a scholarship award for the next academic year. Send your application to Heidi Goldenberg at heidi.j.goldenberg@hofstra.edu.
