Top Ten Tips for New Students

1. **Student Organizations** – What do you plan to do outside the classroom? Hofstra has over 200 different student organizations. Your first step to getting involved is by attending the upcoming spring involvement fair on Sunday, August 31, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m. For the full events list and more information about the organizations on campus, check out <http://hofstra.campuslabs.com/engage>.
2. **HofstraPass** - When on campus, your HofstraPass (identification card) will assist you in accessing spaces on campus (such as your residence hall if you are a residential student), your meal plan in any of our on-campus dining facilities, books and resources in Axinn Library, the Fitness Center and its equipment and free/discounted tickets to athletics, cultural events and performances.
3. **This Week At Hofstra** - Looking for what's happening each week at Hofstra? The Orientation and New Student Programs sends out an email every Sunday to your Pride account with a list of all upcoming events!
4. **Parking** – All vehicles must be registered with the department of Public Safety before parking on campus. A map of designated parking lots and policies can be found at www.hofstra.edu/parking
5. **Dining on campus** - Hofstra's dining program boasts 18 retail restaurants locations, including Hof USA, a student favorite, offering late night dining from 6 p.m to 3 a.m., seven days a week. Each location has its own identity with numerous food concepts and a large variety of grab & go items that can be enjoyed anywhere, anytime.
6. **Transportation** – The university offers free campus shuttles to both Mineola and Hempstead LIRR stations. Schedules are available online at www.hofstra.edu/directions
7. **Writing Center** – Have experts review and assess your work. The Writing Center is located in 102 Mason Hall. Virtual appointments are available and can be made at www.hofstra.edu/writingcenter
8. **Library and Tutorial Services** – The Axinn Library is located at the south end of the Unispan (pedestrian bridge) connecting the student center. In addition to research materials and computers, the university's tutorial program is also housed here. Group and individual tutoring sessions are available. Don't need a tutor? You can also become a tutor in a subject through the Center for Academic Excellence.
9. **Religious / Spiritual Life on Campus** - The Interfaith Center at Hofstra University consists of the Jewish, Muslim, Protestant, and Roman Catholic chaplains and their ministries. lookout for virtual services and celebrations as the spring semester begins.
10. **Corq** - Download and install the Corq app on your mobile device as it will be used to check you in at student organization, departmental and campus events.

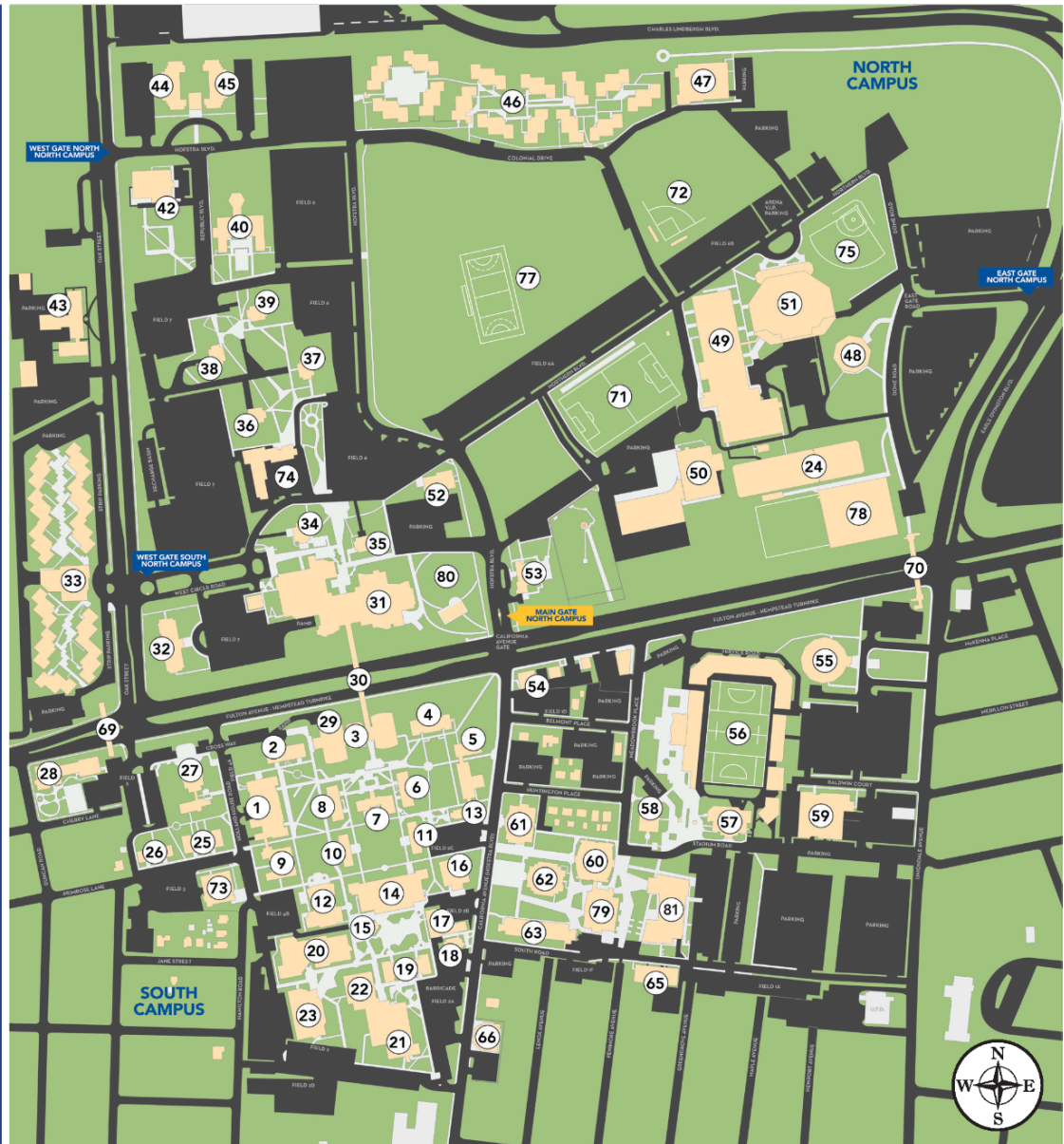
